## **Earthquake Safety Rules**

Suggested safety rules during and after the shaking are as follows:

During the shaking:

- 1. Do not panic, keep calm.
- 2. Douse all fires.
- 3. If the earthquake catches you indoors, stay indoors. Take cover under a sturdy piece of furniture. Stay away from glass, or loose hanging objects.
- 4. If you are outside, move away from buildings, steep slopes and utility wires.
- 5. If you are in a moving vehicle, stop as quickly as safety permits, but stay in the vehicle until the shaking stops.
- 6. If you are in a lift, get out of the lift as quickly as possible.
- 7. If you are in a tunnel, move out of the tunnel to the open as quickly as safety permits.

## After the shaking:

- 1. Check for casualties and seek assistance if needed.
- 2. If you suspect a gas leak, open windows and shut off the main valve. Leave the building and report the gas leaks. Do not light a fire.
- 3. If the electrical wiring is damaged, shut off power at the mains supply. Turn off the mains valve if water supply is damaged.
- 4. Do not use the telephone except to report an emergency or to obtain assistance.
- 5. Stay out of severely damaged buildings; aftershocks may cause them to collapse. Report any building damage to the authorities
